WATER INDUSTRY ACT: SECTION 19(1)(b)

Consumers near East Grinstead in West Sussex who might be affected by investigating work being carried out by South East Water Limited at its Grovelands Water Supply Zone will wish to be aware of the following information:

The Company has found through its water quality monitoring programme that water supplies in this zone fail on occasion to meet the standard for total coliforms (as required by the Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations 1989). These failures do not make the water unsafe to drink at any time. The Secretary of State for the

Environment has notified the Company that he will, if necessary, order the Company to take appropriate steps to ensure that the water supplied will in future meet the required standard.

The Company has given the Secretary of State a legally binding undertaking to carry out appropriate investigatory work at Grovelands Water Supply Zone to be completed by 30th April 1997. The Secretary of State has informed the Company that he is satisfied

it is complying with this undertaking, by serving on them the following notice: THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT:

- is satisfied that South East Water Limited "the Company" in supplying water from Grovelands Water Supply Zone is contravening and is likely to do so again its duty to supply wholesome water under section 68(1)(a) of the Water Industry Act 1991, and the requirement of regulation 3(7) of the Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations 1989 that water supplied should not contain total coliforms.
 has notified South East Water Limited on 22nd May 1996 that

- notes that South East Water Limited has on 2nd September 1996 given an undertaking under section 19(1)(b) of the Water Industry Act 1991 to take the following steps by the dates shown:
 - (a) Investigate possible cause of bacterial contamination by:
 - (i) On each compliance sampling occasion from a random selected customer property, in the supply zone, for bacteriological examination, duplicate sampling to be undertaken from properties served on the same main and on either side. To continue for the duration of the Undertaking.
 (ii) Review with the DWI monitoring data through the

(ii) Review with the DWI monitoring data through the period to assess any appropriate remedial action. To be completed by 31st March 1997.

(iii) If necessary, submit a further Undertaking detailing remedial work necessary. To be completed by 30th April 1997.

4. is satisfied that South East Water Limited has given and is complying with an undertaking to take all such steps as appear to the Secretary of State for the time being to be appropriate to secure or facilitate compliance with the requirement of Regulation 3(6) of the Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations 1989.
