#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of areas of highway and footpath at or in the vicinity of Leazes Road, Leazes Bowl Road, Market Place and Claypath, Durham City, in the county of Durham.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Boots Properties PLC by the City of Durham Council on 22nd February 1996, under reference 4/95/111.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours during 28 days commencing on 21st October 1996 at the offices of The City of Durham Council, Byland Lodge, Hawthorne Terrace, Durham and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Department of Transport (quoting reference DN5053/35/1/302) at the address stated below.

Any person may object to the making of the proposed Order within the period of 28 days commencing on 21st October 1996 by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, quoting the above reference, at the office of the Director Planning, Environment and Transport, Government Office for the North East, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle upon Tyne NE1 4TD.
