#### Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Take notice that W. S. Bayston and Son Ltd., of Coldhill Farm, Aberford, Leeds, is applying to the Environment Agency to vary licence serial number 2/27/24/294 to abstract water from a borehole in the Lower Magnesian Limestone at National Grid Reference SE 471 361 at Coldhill Farm in the parish of Saxton cum Scarthingwell, in the Selby District of North Yorkshire.

The variation being applied for is to increase the annual volume authorised to be abstracted between the months of April and September for spray irrigation from 52,000 cubic metres to 122,000 cubic metres.

#### Proposed net Limitation Order and Fisheries Byelaws

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has appointed B. J. James to hold a local inquiry further to section 26 of the Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries Act 1975 in respect of the application by South West Region of the Environment Agency for confirmation of an Order limiting the number of net licences to be issued for fishing for salmon and trout in those public tidal waters and those parts of the sea to a distance of six nautical miles measured from the baselines from which the breadth of the territorial sea is measured between a line drawn due west from the northernmost point of Marsland Mouth, at National Grid Reference SS2100 1747 and a line drawn due north from the coast near Foreland Point, at National Grid Reference SS 7550 5125; and further to Schedule 26, paragraph 2(1) of the Water Resources Act 1991 in respect of the application by South West Region of the Environment Agency for confirmation of byelaws regulating the taking of salmon and trout in the Rivers Taw and Torridge.
