## SCHEDULE 1

*Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council (Arrail Street, Six Bells, Abertillery) (Street Parking Place for Disabled Persons) Order 1996*

Notice is hereby given that the Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police have, on 24th October 1996, made the above Order.

The effect of the Order will be to authorise that part of the road specified in the Schedule to this notice to be used as a parking place for invalid carriages, vehicles issued to a disabled person by the Ministry of Health in lieu of an invalid carriage and any vehicle which bears at the front and in a conspicuous position badges issued by a Local Authority to the driver in pursuance of the scheme under section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948 and section 21 of the Chronically Sick & Disabled Persons Act 1970.

The Order will come into operation on 30th October 1996.

The Order and a map showing the affected road may be inspected at Room 405, Civic Centre, Ebbw Vale, during normal office hours from Monday to Friday.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 24th October 1996, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Bridgend County Council (John Street, Porthcawl) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1996*

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd October 1996, the Bridgend County Borough Council made an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, on the side of length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice, and to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle at any time on the sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

Exemptions are provided in the Order to enable Medical Practitioners and Veterinary Surgeons to visit while "on call" and for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works, the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, inspection or survey of the sides of lengths of road, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 3 hours (with return prohibited within 1 hour) on the sides of lengths of road concerned.

The Order came into operation on 24th October 1996, and a copy thereof and a map showing the sides of lengths of road to which the Order relates, may be inspected at the offices of Bridgend County Borough Council, Civic Offices, Angel Street, Bridgend, during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 23rd October 1996, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

*The Bridgend County Council (John Street, Porthcawl) (Limitation of Waiting) Order 1996*

Exemptions are provided in the Order to enable Medical Practitioners and Veterinary surgeons to visit while "on call" and for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and road works, the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, inspection or survey of the sides of lengths of road, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge are allowed to wait on the sides of lengths of road concerned.

*Bridgend County Borough Council (John Street, Porthcawl) (Bus Stop Clearway) Order 1996*

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd October 1996, the Bridgend County Borough Council made an Order under sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle, other than a public service vehicle to wait between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day on the eastern
