

Traffic wishing to turn right into the link road from the westbound main carriageway of Colchester Road would do so by keeping to the right of the traffic island in the westbound main carriageway, traffic wishing to go straight ahead on the westbound main carriageway would keep to the left of the traffic island. Traffic wishing to turn left in to the link road from the eastbound main carriageway of Colchester Road would do so by keeping to the left of the triangular island on the west side of the junction of Colchester Road with the link road, traffic wishing to go straight ahead on the eastbound main carriageway would keep to the right of the triangular island. Traffic wishing to turn right into the westbound carriageway of Colchester Road from the new link road would be required to keep to the right of the triangular island on the east side of the link road, traffic wishing to turn left onto the eastbound main carriageway of Colchester Road from the new link road would be required to keep to the left of the triangular island.
