Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that Rupert Gooddy Plants Ltd., of Buckland Road, Bampton, Oxfordshire OX18 2AA, is applying to the Environment Agency for a licence to abstract water from a groundwater seepage reservoir at National Grid Reference SP32450296, at Buckland Road, Bampton, Oxfordshire.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 10 cubic metres per hour, 200 cubic metres per day, 25,000 cubic metres per year between 1st January and 31st December each year. The water will be used for spray irrigation.

Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that J. F. Temple & Son Ltd., of New Farm, Wells, Norfolk NR23 1NE, is applying to the Environment Agency to vary licence serial number 7/34/3/S/39 to abstract water from Marsh Drains, at Wells, Norfolk, National Grid Reference TF92634309, at Stiffkey Road, Wells, Norfolk. The variation being applied for is to increase the licenced quantity by 58,000 cubic metres to 73,000 cubic metres and to add a small area of land on the northern edge of Wells marshes. In addition, the above are applying to the Environment Agency to vary licence serial number 7/34/3/G/52 to abstract water from chalk at Wighton, Norfolk, National Grid Reference TF94983957, at Binham Road, Wighton, Norfolk. The variation being applied for is to increase the licenced quantity by 31,810 cubic metres to 100,000 cubic metres to add 2 areas of land to the north and south of Binham Road, Wighton.

BOLTON METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Bolton (Winter Hey Lane, Horwich) (One-way Traffic) (Experimental) (No.) Order 1996

The Bolton (Winter Hey Lane, Horwich) (Prohibition of Driving and Loading Bay) (Experimental) (No.) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that, the Borough Council of Bolton propose to make Orders under sections 9, 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposal will be as follows:

One-way Traffic; Winter Hey Lane from Lee Lane to Captain Street permitted direction of travel, south-west bound.

Prohibition of Driving; Winter Hey Lane from Lee Lane to 8 metres north-east of Captain Street.

Loading Bay; Winter Hey Lane, area bounded by full carriageway width from Captain Street for 8 metres in a north-easterly direction.

It is the Council's intention that both these Orders will operate separately for up to 18 months, beginning with proposed Order 1, after the expiry of which proposed Order 2 will become operative.
