1. An Order under sections 10, 41 and 106 of the Highways Act 1980, which will provide that the roads which he proposes to contruct along the following routes shall become trunk roads, from the date when the Order comes into force:

- (a) a route ("the main route") about 1.7 kilometres in length, starting from a point about 400 metres south of the centre of the A249 Iwade Bypass northern terminal roundabout (Kingsferry Interchange) and proceeding generally northwards to a point about 250 metres north-east of the point where the road crosses the Sittingbourne to Sheerness Railway line;
- (b) a route ("the main route") about 2.7 kilometres in length, from a point on the existing trunk road about 100 metres southwest of its junction with Ferry Road and proceeding generally northwards to a point about 450 metres north of the A249 Queenborough roundabout; and
- (c) authorise him to contruct as part of the new road on the main route at (a) above a bridge over the navigable waters of the Swale.

2. An Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980, which will provide that lengths of the trunk road to be superseded by the new trunk road on the main routes shall cease to be trunk road, and shall be classified as classified road, as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the Kent County Council (who will become the highway authority responsible for the lengths) that the new trunk road on the main routes is open for traffic.

3. An Order under sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980, which will provide that the slip roads which he proposes to construct along the following routes shall become trunk roads, from the date when this Order comes into force:

- (a) a route about 370 metres in length to connect the northbound carriageway of the main route to the A249 Iwade Bypass northern terminal roundabout (Kingsferry Interchange); and
- (b) a route about 690 metres in length to connect the A249 Iwade Bypass northern terminal roundabout (Kingsferry Interchange) to the southbound carriageway of the main route.

4. An Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the A249 trunk road and the new trunk roads to be contructed by him, from a point on A249 Iwade Bypass about 400 metres south of the Iwade Bypass northern terminal roundabout (Kingsferry Interchange) to a point about 450 metres north on Queenborough roundabout on the Isle of Sheppey, in the county of Kent, which will:

(1) authorise him to,

- (a) improve highways;
- (b) stop up highways;
- (c) construct new highways;
- (d) stop up private means of access to premises; and
- (e) provide new means of access to premises,

all on or in the vicinity of the A249 trunk road or the new trunk roads; and

(2) provide for the transfer of each new highway to the Kent County Council as highway authority, from the date on which he notifies them that it has been completed and is open for traffic.
