If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Mr Sohal by Ashfield District Council, on 20th April 1994 under Ref. 94/0127.

The proposed Order will also authorise the improvement of existing highway by Mr. Sohal, maintainable at public expense, and for which the highway authority is to be the Nottinghamshire County Council.
