#### **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

Proposed Stopping-Up of a Highway at Chadderton, Oldham

Notice is hereby given that a local inquiry is to be held in connection with the proposal of the Secretary of State for Transport to make an Order under section 247 authorising the stopping-up of an unnamed passageway at Chadderton to the side and rear of No. 284 Moston Lane East, Manchester, and to the rear of properties No. 286 Moston Lane East, Manchester and of Nos. 633 and 635 Broadway, Chadderton.
