### PUBLIC NOTIFICATION OF APPLICATION MADE UNDER SECTION II OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990, PART I

#### *Integrated Pollution Control*

Notice is hereby given that Bitrez Limited has applied to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Integrated Pollution Control (IPC) authorisation to operate a chemical process as prescribed in Paragraph (D) of section 4.2 at Bradley Hall Trading Estate, Bradley Lane, Standish, Wigan, Lancashire, in the Borough and District of Wigan in the County of Lancashire.

In this case there will be included in the register a statement indicating only that representations have been made which have been the subject of such a request.
