## PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT 1975

*Notice of the issue of a submarine pipe-line works authorisation*

The Secretary of State for Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Shell UK Limited, whose address is Shell-Mex House, The Strand, London WC2R 0DX, for the construction of two 219.1 millimetre pipe-lines and two chemical injection umbilicals between the Kittiwake platform and the Mallard Subsea Drilling Centre.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, one 219.1 millimetre pipe-line shall only be used to convey production fluids and the other for de-aerated water, the chemical injection umbilicals shall only be used to convey methanol and corrosion inhibitors.

The pipe-lines may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.

Shell Expro has been appointed operator of the pipe-lines.

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

*Notice of Public Highway Order**The White Lea Farm, Tow Law, Durham Diversion (No. 1) Order  
1997*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 247, 253 and 261 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, proposes to make a Diversion Order if planning permission is granted by him for the extraction of minerals by surface working.

The effect of the Order will be to divert lengths of footpaths Nos. 3, 3a, 4 and 9 Wolsingham, footpaths Nos. 19 and 197 Crook and Willington, and bridleways Nos. 21 and 23 Crook and Willington. The lines and situation of the existing and proposed alternative highways are shown on drawing 110/D23A annexed to the Order.
