#### *Declaration of National Nature Reserve, Parish of Ruislip—County of Hertfordshire*

#### *Notice of application for a licence to abstract water*

### POWERGEN CHP LTD.

*Notice of an application for consent to construct and operate a combined heat and power plant at Bridgewater Paper Company, Ellesmere Port, in the borough of Ellesmere Port and Neston.*

Notice is hereby given that PowerGen CHP Ltd., has applied under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989, for the consent of the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry to construct and operate a combined heat and power plant at Bridgewater Paper Company, Ellesmere Port, in the borough of Ellesmere Port and Neston. The section 36 area lies within the following grid reference: SJ 3900 7880.

The new combined heat and power plant (CHP Plant), will have a total electrical capacity of up to approximately 65 megawatts (MWe) and a thermal output capacity of approximately 105 Megawatts (MWth). The new CHP Plant will comprise new equipment including a gas turbine, a steam turbine, a waste heat boiler and five stand by boilers and associated auxiliaries. The plant will include a new gas pipeline to bring gas to site from the National Transmission System and this is subject to a separate planning application.

## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

### CHESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*Cheshire County Council (Princess Street, Knutsford, Borough of Macclesfield) (Traffic Management) Order 1997*
