

(c) restrict traffic to travelling eastwards only in the new length of trunk road from a point on the trunk road 40 metres south of its junction with the A522 westwards for a distance of 30 metres.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. An Order under sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980, which will provide that two routes which he proposes to construct to connect the A50 Trunk Road with other highways at Uttoxeter in the county of Staffordshire, shall become trunk roads from the date when the Order comes into force.

2. An Order under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the A50 Trunk Road and the new Trunk Roads to be constructed by him at Uttoxeter in the county of Staffordshire, which will authorise him to:

- (a) improve lengths of the A522 road, and
  - (b) stop up part of the trunk road,
- all at Uttoxeter in the said county.
