ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gloucestershire County Council (Russell Street and Kendrick Street, Stroud) (Prohibition of Public Service Vehicles) Order 1997

Notice is hereby given that the Gloucestershire County Council have made an Order under section 19 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit any person from causing or permitting a Public Service Vehicle with more than 33 seats to proceed at any time along the lengths of roads in the town and district of Stroud in the county of Gloucestershire and known as:

Russell Street, from its junction with Rowcroft and its junction with George Street;

Kendrick Street, between its junction with George Street and its junction with Russell Street.

Exemptions will apply to permit Public Service Vehicles to proceed along the lengths of roads described above to enable it to gain access to the railway station in Station Road for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers at the said station only.

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on 28th July 1997, together with the relevant plan, statement of reasons and the Inspector's report/recommendations following the Public Inquiry, may be inspected, during normal office hours, at Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, and Stroud Public Library, Lansdown, Stroud, Gloucestershire, during their normal opening times.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, or on the ground that any requirement to that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose. LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON

The Croydon (Prescribed Routes) (No.) Traffic Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Croydon propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to introduce a ban on all vehicles over 3.40 metres (11 feet) laden height from entering that length of highway lying immediately below Dagnall Park Railway Bridge.
