Stopping-up of Estuary Road, Exmouth Docks, Devon

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Devon) (No. SW 7) Order 1997" authorising the stopping-up of Estuary Road, Exmouth Docks, Devon, to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission referred to in that Schedule, and requiring the provision of a new means of access along the route shown by diagonal hatching on the deposited plan, which shall not be a highway and shall be privately maintained.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 14th August 1997 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
