## Madrid, November 16.

Y a Courier from Badajoz we have an Account, that Don Antonio Amezaga, Captain-General of Estremadura, died there a few Days ago of an Apoplexy. The Court has Advice from Rome, that the Diffesences with the Pope are not yet in any likelihood of being adjusted, and particularly one chief Point infisted on by this Crown, viz. That the Pope shall not grant Pensions to Foreigners, upon such Benefices as ought to be conferred on Natives of this Kingdom. Don Antonio del Valle, who was nominated Governour of Galicia, in the Room of the Marquels de Risbourg, has excused himself from accepting that Employment, having ta-ken a Resolution to pass the rest of his Life in a Religious Retirement, and for that Purpose to go into a Convent of Augustine Monks. The Marques de Risbourg having not yet accepted the Command of the Regiment of Walloon Guards, on the Terms established by the late Reform of the Troops, 'tis believed he designs to quit Spain, as several other Officers of the Walloon Regiments, who have Estates in the Austrian Netherlands, feem disposed to do likewise. Sig. Mocenigo is arrived here, with a publick Character from the State of Venice.

Whereas His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales bath been pleased to appoint a Board, consisting of General Officers, and others, to examine into the Pretensions of all Persons, who do claim, or at present enjoy, the Benerat fit of half Pay upon the Establishment of Great Britain, as reduced Officers of the Land Forces or Marines. These are to give Notice, that the several reduced Officers upon half Pay, lately belonging to the following Regiments, are hereby required to appear in Person, before the said Board, in the great Room at the Horse Guards, upon the respective Days following, at Ien of the Clock in the Morning, and they are to bring with them their Commissions, or authentick Certificates of them, in order to beir Examination: And such of them as do not appear, will be struck off the Half Pay.

And it being His Royal Highnes's Command, That the Field-Officers and Agents of the said Regiments should likewise attend at the same Time, They are bereby required so to do.
