Notice of application for consent in pursuance of Schedule 10

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991, as amended by the Environment Act 1995, that an application has been made to the Environment Agency by Parripak Foods Limited, for consent to discharge trade effluent. The application is for a consent to discharge up to a maximum of 229 cubic metres per day of treated trade effluent derived from vegetable washing from Parripak Foods Ltd., Sandy Lane, Chicksands, Bedfordshire, in the Haynes Brook, at National Grid Reference TL 1288 3997. The application is to allow for an increased flow of treated trade effluent from this site at times when the capacity of the reed bed or balancing lagoon is exceeded. Chicksands is within the Mid Bedfordshire District Council and Bedfordshire County Council areas. The recognised uses of the Haynes Brook include moderate amenity, spray irrigation and livestock watering.
