

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 12th November 1997, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

The A580 East Lancashire Road (The M6 Motorway) (Junction 23) (Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 1997

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he intends to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A580 East Lancashire Road and the M6 Motorway Junction 23 in the county of Merseyside.

The effect of the Order will be to prevent vehicles making a right turn onto the eastbound and the westbound carriageways of the

A580 East Lancashire Road from the north-eastern segment of the roundabout on the east side of junction 23.

The prohibition will not apply to:

- (a) any vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes; or
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform.
