

LONDON BOROUGH OF ENFIELD

Advent and Leigh Hunt Drive—Waiting Restrictions

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield, on 10th November 1997, made the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. 89) Order 1997, under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The general effect of the Order will be further to amend the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) Order 1994, so that:

- (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited:
 - (i) between 7 a.m. and 6.30 p.m., on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, in the lengths of street specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
 - (ii) between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m., on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, in the lengths of street specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m., on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, in the lengths of streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above;
- (c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle in the lengths of streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by Enfield Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is affected;
- (d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the lengths of streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above will be prohibited.

3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2(a) and (b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a parking attendant, or in certain circumstances, e.g. the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" will apply.

4. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 1st December 1997, of maps indicating the location and effect of the Order, of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order and of the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) Order 1994 (and the Orders which have previously amended or applied that Order), can be inspected at the Reception Desk, "B" Block, the Civic Centre, Silver Street, Enfield, Middlesex EN1 3XD, during the normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made.

5. Copies of the Order may be obtained from the Traffic Engineering Group, the Civic Centre, Silver Street, Enfield, Middlesex EN1 3XD.

6. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE 1

No Waiting—7 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive

Advent Way:

- (a) the north-west side
 - (i) between a point 38 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Eley Road and a point 12 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Eley Road;
 - (ii) between a point 60 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Eley Road and a point 105 metres south-west of that kerb-line, excluding the access roads;

(iii) between the eastern kerb-line of the access road leading to the Angel Road Works and a point 18 metres east of that kerb-line;

- (b) the south-west side, between a point 38 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Eley Road and its south-western extremity, so much of the carriageway that is public highway.

SCHEDULE 2

No Waiting—8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive
Leigh Hunt Drive, the west to south-west arm:

- (a) the north, north-east, east and south-east side, between a point 75 metres east of the eastern boundary of No. 96 High Street, Southgate and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 211 and 212 Leigh Hunt Drive;
- (b) the south, south-west, west and north-west side, between a point 75 metres east of the eastern boundary of No. 96 High Street, Southgate and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 211 and 212 Leigh Hunt Drive, excluding all the access roads.

Leigh Hunt Drive, that length leading to Nos. 220 to 257 which lies between Nos. 219 and 258 Leigh Hunt Drive;
between the eastern kerb-line of the west to south-west arm of Leigh Hunt Drive and a point 18 metres east of that kerb-line.

Malvern Terrace, Mansfield Close and The Glade—Waiting Restrictions

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield on 10th November 1997 made the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. 88) Order 1997 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The general effect of the Order will be further to amend the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) Order 1994, so that:

- (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. throughout the week in the lengths of streets referred to in subparagraph (a) above;
- (c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle in the lengths of streets referred to in subparagraph (a) above will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by Enfield Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
