Enfield Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the street referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above, will be prohibited.

6. The restrictions imposed by the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) Order 1994, will apply to any area previously designated as a parking place and not redesignated as such, as they apply in the immediate vicinity

7. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 5(a) and (b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a parking attendant or in certain circumstances, e.g. the picking up or setting down of passengers, the carrying out of statutory powers or duties, the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations, to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying an "Orange Badge" will apply. 8. The Arnos Grove Residents' Parking Places Order, the Business
