## CHICHESTER DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The Chichester District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1989 (Amendment No. 1) Order 1998*

Notice is hereby given that the Council propose to make an Order under sections 35(1) and 124(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to amend The District Council of Chichester (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1989 as follows:

- amending the scale of charges made for the use of parking places in Chichester in accordance with the particulars described in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice;
- introducing an hourly charge in Tariff B car parks to replace the present two-hour banding charge;
- increasing the level of parking fees in the Woolstaplers car park from Tariff B to Tariff A charges;
- removing the specific season ticket facility at the Avenue de Chartres (decked) car park;
- amending the hours during which charges are made for all car parks from Monday to Friday from 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. to 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.;
- amending the hours during which charges are made for Tariff A car parks on Saturdays only from 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. to 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.; and
- increasing the excess charge discounted sum from £15 to £20.

A copy of this draft Order, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order are available for inspection at East Pallant House, Chichester, and at the Council's Area Offices at Midhurst and Petworth during normal office hours until Wednesday, 31st December 1997.

In all other respects the present provisions of the 1989 Order will remain in force.

Objections to the foregoing proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned on or before Wednesday, 31st December 1997. The contact officer is Roger Yardley (telephone Chichester 785166 extension 4654 or direct line 534654).

This notice replaces the notice which appeared in this publication on 27th November 1997. The only amendment made from the previous notice is to extend the closing date for objections.
