

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that under the powers contained in section 333(7) of the above Act he proposes to vary an Order made under section 249 of the above Act known as The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (County of West Yorkshire) (Bradford No. 1) Order 1995. He proposes to amend Schedule 2 (1) of the Order by the addition of item (f) exempting a vehicle being used in accordance with a special authorisation for that use given by the local highway authority.

The A66 Trunk Road (Whinell, Penrith) (Derestriction) Order 1997

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A50 Trunk Road (Derby Southern Bypass) (Prohibition of Right Turns and U-Turns) Order

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle:

- (i) from making a U-turn from the westbound carriageway of the A50 through the gap in the central reservation between Rookery Lane and Warren Lane;
- (ii) from making a U-turn from the eastbound carriageway of the A50 through the gap in the central reservation between Warren Lane and Rookery Lane;
- (iii) when entering the A50 from Rookery Lane from making a right turn through the gap in the central reservation opposite; or
- (iv) when entering the A50 from Warren Lane from making a right turn through the gap in the central reservation opposite.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A50 Trunk Road (Derby Spur) (Derestriction) Order

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he intends to make an Order under sections 82(2) and 83(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to remove the 30 m.p.h. speed limit that automatically applied upon the energising of street lighting on a length of the A50 Trunk Road known as the Derby Spur, in the district of Derbyshire, from its junction with Derby Spur Roundabout (including 150 metres of the A6 filter lane from south to west), to its junction with the new A50 trunk road (Derby Southern Bypass) including all the connecting roads.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A6 Trunk Road (Derby Spur) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to impose a 40 m.p.h. speed limit on the A6 Trunk Road from a point 210 metres north-west of the Snelsmoor Lane Roundabout to a point 230 metres south-east of Derby Spur Roundabout, including both roundabouts. This limit will also apply to 130 metres of the A6 filter lane connecting the northbound carriageway of the Derby Spur to the westbound carriageway of the A6 at the Derby Spur Roundabout.
