*Further Public Consultation on the justification for the Production
of Mixed Oxide Fuel at BNF PLC Sellafield*

After considering the issues raised during its consultation in 1997, on the justification and operation of BNF plc's Mixed Oxide Fuel (MOX) Plant at Sellafield, the Environment Agency commissioned an independent assessment, by PA Consulting Group, of the Company's economic case for the plant

The Agency is undertaking further consultation on this new information

*Draft Variations to the existing Certificates of Authorisation to
dispose of Gaseous and Liquid Radioactive Waste*

The Environment Agency is considering applications from British Nuclear Fuels plc in accordance with the Radioactive Substances Act 1993, to vary the existing certificates of authorisation to dispose of gaseous and liquid radioactive wastes from its premises at Sellafield, Seascale, in the county of Cumbria
