HIGHWAYS AGENCY

The A580 Trunk Road (East Lancashire Road—Haydock Lane) (Prohibition of Right Turns and U-Turns) Order 199

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he intends to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A580 East Lancashire Road in the district of St. Helens.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit:

- vehicles from entering or proceeding through the gap in the central reservation of the trunk road opposite the junction with Haydock Lane (northern section);
- vehicles travelling in the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road from making a U-turn through the gap in the central reservation opposite to Haydock Lane (southern section), and
- vehicles travelling in the westbound carriageway from entering or proceeding through the gap in the central reservation of the trunk road opposite the junction with Haydock Lane (southern section). This includes vehicles joining the trunk road from Haydock Lane.

The prohibition in items (b) and (c) will not apply to:

- a vehicle being used for fire, police or ambulance purposes, and
- anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a police constable in uniform.
