CAERPHILLY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Caerphilly County Borough Council (Off Street Parking) (Raglan Street Car and Lorry Park, Risca) Order 1998

Notice is hereby given that on 27th February 1998 the Caerphilly County Borough Council made an Order under section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers the effect of which is to regulate the use of the parking places named in

the Schedule to this notice which shows the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation and the maximum period for waiting permissible for each parking place. The Order comes into force on 9th March 1998.

Notice of the proposal to make the Order was previously published in *The London Gazette* on 17th June 1996, Issue No. 54438, Ref. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any of the relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from 27th February 1998, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

CARMARTHENSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Carmarthenshire (Restricted Roads) Order 1998

(Imposition of 30 m.p.h. Speed Limited on the Class III Saron to Drefach Felindre Road)

Notice is hereby given that on 27th February 1998, the Carmarthenshire County Council made an Order under sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Act 1984 ("the Act").

The effect of this Order is that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice become subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.
