TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Stopping-up of a Highway at Warrington

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that on the application of W S Atkins North West, on behalf of the Commission for the New Towns (CNT) he has made an Order under section 248 of the above Act entitled "The County of Cheshire, Pewterspear District Distributor Road Phase 2 (Pewterspear to Appleton Cross, Warrington, Cheshire) Road Scheme (Stopping-up) Order 1998", authorising the stopping-up of a length of Cann Lane, Appleton Cross, Warrington, Cheshire.

Copies of the above-named Orders may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the Government Office for the North West (Transport), Sunley Tower, Piccadilly Plaza, Manchester M1 4BE (quoting reference GO/TNW 5150/35/1/12), and may be inspected at

all reasonable hours at the offices of Warrington Borough Council, Town Hall, Sankey Street, Warrington.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 20th March 1998, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of three areas of highway at Upper Charles Street, one area at St. Mary's Road, one area at Twynham Road and one area at Southwell Park Road, all situated to the west of Park Street, Camberley, in the county of Surrey.

The proposed Order will not be made unless planning permission for the development described in the Schedule to this notice is granted, and in that event the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development to be carried out in accordance with that planning permission Planning permission for that development was applied for to Surrey Heath Borough Council by Surrey Heath Borough Council and THI plc, on 7th November 1997, under application number 97/1097.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours during the 28 days commencing on 26th March 1998, at the offices of Surrey Heath Borough Council, Surrey Heath House, Knoll Road, Camberley, Surrey GU15 3HD, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Head of Transport (East), Government Office for the South East (quoting reference GOSE/029/001/SYHE/002), at the address below.

During the above-mentioned period of 28 days anyone may object to the making of the Order by writing to the Secretary of State, quoting reference GOSE/029/001/SYHE/002 and addressing their objection to the Head of Transport (East), Government Office for the South East, First Floor, Bridge House, 1 Walnut Tree Close, Guildford GU1 4GA. In the preparation of an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection may be communicated to the applicant and other people who may be affected by it.
