## LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON

### The Croydon (Free Parking Places) (Community Health Concessionary Permit) (No 1) Traffic Order 1998

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Croydon on 30th March 1998, made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985

2 The general effect of the Free Parking Places Order will be

- (a) to designate a free parking place in Dennett Road, Croydon, on the south side, from a point 13 60 metres west of the western kerb-line of Handcroft Road westward for a distance of 7 metres.
- (b) to provide that the parking place would be in operation between the hours of 7 a m and 7 p m, on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive,
- (c) to specify that the use of the parking place will be restricted to passenger vehicles for which a community health concessionary permit has been issued by the Council,
- (d) to provide that the parking place may be suspended when necessary to facilitate the carrying out of certain functions such as street works, furniture removals, funerals etc.,

3 The prohibitions and restrictions referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply to certain vehicles viz, to police, fire brigade and ambulance vehicles, to broken down vehicles and those being used in connection with building and street works or for the collection or delivery of postal packets, etc

6 Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof, or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court

#### The London Borough of Croydon Disabled Persons Parking Places—Schedule 32

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Croydon propose to make the Croydon (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No X) Order 199X under sections 6 and 124 of and Park IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985

The general effect of the Order would be to

- (a) designate new parking places in Barmouth Road, Shirley (outside No 54), Benhurst Gardens, Selsdon (outside No 63), Betchworth Way, New Addington (outside No 4), Bingham Road, Addiscombe (outside No 166), Brierley, New Addington (outside No 63), Bute Road, Croydon (outside No 5), Granville Close, East Croydon (adjacent to Nos 1 to 3), Hayes Lane, Kenley (outside No 141), Henderson Road Selhurst (outside No 6), Leander Road, Thornton Heath (outside No 122), Mersham Road, Thornton Heath (outside Nos 228/230), Myrtle Road, Shirley (outside No 46), Salcot Crescent, New Addington (outside Nos 112/11f), Sandringham Road, Thornton Heath (outside No 14),
- (b) provide that the parking places would operate 'At Any Time', (c) specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled persons' badge (commonly referred to as the 'Orange Badge') issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975 or 1982, as amended, may be left therein, and
- (d) provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e g to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes) etc

A copy of the proposed Order and of all related Orders, of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order and of the plans which indicate each length of road to which the Order relates, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published, at the Enquiry Counter, 'One Stop' Facility, Ground Floor, Taberner House Park Lane, Croydon, Surrey
