Notice of application for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of an inland water by means of impounding works

Take notice that Thorpe Park (Leeds) Limited of Park House Westland Road Leeds is applying to the Environment Agency for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of The Beck at National Grid Reference SE 3792 3331 at Brown Moor Austhorpe

Water will be impounded by an on line feature surface water balancing pond and the object of the impounding works is to maintain present maximum stream flows. The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be 3 624 cubic metres.

Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

Take notice that Castle Howard Estate Ltd of The Estate Office Castle Howard York YO60 7DA is applying to the Environment Agency for a licence to abstract water from a catch pit supported by adjacent well points in the drift sands and gravels at National Grid Reference SE 712 751 located at Windale Farm in the parish of Slingsby in the Ryedale district of North Yorkshire.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 114 cubic metres per hour; 2 280 cubic metres per day; 30 000 cubic metres between April and September each year.

The water will be used for spray irrigation. This application is to replace an existing licence which expires 1st October this year.

LONDON BOROUGH OF CAMDEN

The Camden (Bus Stop Clearance) (No.) Traffic Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden propose to make the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 7(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The general effect of the Order will be to prohibit all vehicles other than those exempted from stopping on the bus stop clearance restrictions between 7 am to Midnight Monday to Sunday in Broadhurst Gardens, Cusfield Gardens, Cleve Road, Adelaide Road, Primrose Hill Road, Westbere Road, Highgate West Hill, Mansfield Road, Torrino Avenue, Prince of Wales Road, Belsize Avenue, Belsize Park and prohibit vehicles from stopping at any time on the bus stand in Torrino Avenue.

A copy of the proposed Order, a plan showing the locations and the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected/purchased during normal office hours on Monday to Friday at the Environment Department Reception, Fifth Floor, Camden Town Hall, Argyle Street, WC1H 8EQ.

GREENWICH COUNCIL

The Greenwich (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No 50) Order 1998

Notice is hereby given that Greenwich Council hereinafter called the Council on 23rd July 1998 made the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The general effect of the Order will be to further amend the Greenwich (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1994 so that waiting restrictions operative at any time will be imposed on the lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Details of exemptions from the restrictions for certain vehicles and persons together with restrictions on selling or advertising in a restricted street are contained in the original Order of 1994.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 17th August 1998, a plan showing the locations and effects of the Order, the Order being amended and the Council's statement of reasons for making the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at Development Services, Greenwich Council, Peggy Middleton House, 50 Woolwich New Road, Woolwich, SE18 6HQ for 6 weeks following the date the Order was made and copies of the Order may be obtained from the same address.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks of the making of the Order make application for the purpose to the High Court.
