*Notice of Disclaimer under section 656
of the Companies Act 1985*

In pursuance of the powers granted by section 656 of the Companies Act 1985 the Solicitor for the Affairs of Her Majesty's Treasury, as nominee for the Crown in whom the property and rights of World-Wide Purchasing Agency Limited (No 2894760) (hereinafter called "the Company") vested pursuant to section 654 of the Companies Act 1985 when the Company was dissolved on 19th March 1996, pursuant to section 652 of the Companies Act 1985, hereby disclaims the Crown's title (if any) in the premises demised by a lease dated 13th June 1995 made between The Mayor and Burgesses of the London Borough of Waltham Forest (1) and World-Wide Purchasing Agency Limited(2) situated at Rolls Park Sports Ground, Hickman Avenue, Chingford, London, E4 the vesting of the premises having come to his notice on 28th July 1998

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Worcestershire) (No 5) Order 1998" authorising the stopping-up of the entire length of the footpath known as The Sling, Kidderminster

The Order as made, will authorise the stopping-up only to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the outline planning permission granted by Wyre Forest Council on 15th October 1996 under Ref WF 450/96

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 18th September 1998, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein
