*Proposed stopping-up of a highway at Didsbury, Manchester*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that on the application of J R A Moorhouse, for A & A Properties, he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of a length of Fielden Road, Didsbury, Manchester, from its junction with Moorfield Road South eastwards for 33 metres and requiring the provision of a footpath

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to A & A Properties by Manchester City Council on 10th July 1997, under Ref 051813/FO/SOUTH2/97

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours during 28 days commencing on 26th October 1998 at the Town Hall, Albert Square, Manchester, and at the Merseybank Housing Office, 40 Merseybank Avenue, Chorlton, Manchester, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Government Office for the North West (Transport) (quoting Ref GO/TNW 5082/35/1/66), at the address stated below

Any person may object to the making of the proposed Order within the period of 28 days commencing on 26th October 1998, by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, quoting the above reference, at the Government Office for the North West (Transport), Sunley Tower, Piccadilly Plaza, Manchester M1 4BE

In preparing an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of it may be imparted to other persons who may be affected by it and that those persons may wish to communicate with the objector about it
