upon-Thames (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Special Parking Area) (No 1) Traffic Order 1994, so that In Queens, George and Albert Roads waiting restrictions (otherwise than for loading or unloading a vehicle) will be introduced to apply "At Any Time" at their junctions with Burlington Road and Malden Way Service Road
