REVISED LAYOUT OF ON-STREET PARKING PLACES

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea propose to make the above Orders, the general effect of which would be to provide additional resident parking spaces and/or visitor parking spaces in the following streets by converting existing yellow line or rearranging the parking layout

Ashburn Place	Evelyn Gardens
Clareville Grove	Hereford Square
Collingham Place	Onslow Gardens
Courtfield Gardens	Roland Gardens
Cranley Gardens	Selwood Place
Elm Place	Stanhope Gardens

Additionally, a solo motorcycle bay will be extended in Bina Gardens

FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE BRIXTON "B" CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, on 14th January 1999, made the following Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended

- The Lambeth (Brixton) (Parking Places) (No 1) Order 1999,
- The Lambeth (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No 2) Order 1999,
- The Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No 16) Order 1999, and
- The Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No 79) Order 1999

2 The General nature and effect of the Orders will be to further extend the Brixton "B" Controlled Parking Zone to include the area which lies east and south of the existing zone boundary in Effra Road and Mervan Road, and which will be bounded on the south by Brixton Water Lane (part), on the south-east by Barnwell Road and Raiton Road (part) and on the north-east by Bob Marley Way and Mayall Road (part)

NOTE Chaucer Road, Dulwich Road, Effra Parade, Mayall Road (part), Raiton Road (part), Shakespear Road and Spenser Road will not be included in the Controlled Parking Zone and the proposals for those roads which were advertised as part of the Zone on 28th August 1998 will not now be implemented

3 The Orders will provide that

- parking places will be designated on the streets specified in Schedules 1 to 3 to this notice, motor cycle parking areas will be provided on the streets specified in Schedule 4 to this notice and that those parking places and areas will be for the use of the vehicles described at the beginning of each Schedule
- the parking places on the streets specified in
 - Schedule 1 to this notice will operate between 8 30 a m and 8 30 p m on Mondays to Fridays (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted),
 - Schedule 2 to this notice will operate between 8 30 a m and 5 30 p m on Mondays to Fridays (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted), and

- Schedule 3 to this notice will operate at all times,
- the parking areas specified in Schedule 4 to this notice will operate between 8 30 a m and 5 30 p m on Mondays to Fridays,
- the charge for a ticket ("pay and display") referred to in Schedule 2 to this notice will be at the rate of 20 pence for 10 minutes (£1 20 per hour) up to a maximum of 4 hours with no return within one hour,
- the vehicles referred to in Schedule 2 to this notice in respect of which a charge is paid for a ticket ("pay and display") will be passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles or invalid carriages,
- permits will be issued, on application being made together with payment of the appropriate charge, to any person in respect of a vehicle of the class referred to in sub-paragraph (e) above who satisfies the Council that

- in the case of a resident's permit, they are a resident of any street or part of a street specified in Schedule 5 to this notice,
- in the case of a business permit, they carry out a business in any street or part of a street specified in sub-paragraph (f)(i) above and the vehicle is essential to the daily operation of that business,
- in the case of a visitor's permit, they are a resident of any street or part of a street specified in sub-paragraph (f)(i) above and such permit is to be used by a bona fide visitor to their premises,
- in the case of a trade permit, they are either a resident or a business user of a trades person in respect of premises in any street or part of a street specified in sub-paragraph (f)(i) above, and the vehicle is being used in connection with the carrying out of any building, servicing, maintenance or similar work at those premises,
- in the case of a teacher's permit, they are a teacher at a school within any street or part of a street specified in sub-paragraph (f)(i) above which does not have off-street parking facilities

NOTE Permits issued in respect of parking in the current Brixton "B" Controlled Parking Zone will be available for use in similar parking places in the further extension area and vice versa

(g) charges for permits will be as follows—

- for a resident's permit £10 for 1 month, £20 for 3 months, £35 for 6 months or £60 for 12 months,
- for a resident's motor cycle permit £11 for 3 months, £17 for 6 months or £29 for 12 months,
- for a business or teacher's permit £255 for 12 months,
- for a trade permit £12 50 a day for up to four permits purchased at any one time or £10 a day for five permits or over purchased at any one time, and
- for a visitors permit £2 50 a day,

(h) certain vehicles may wait free of charge in the parking places referred to in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice in certain circumstances, e g to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load and unload (maximum 20 minutes) and vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" in accordance with the regulations relating to the use of that badge (no time limit),

(i) new restrictions on waiting by vehicles will generally apply between 8 30 a m and 5 30 p m on Mondays to Fridays in certain streets and parts of streets within the area referred to in paragraph 2 above. In certain parts of those streets, existing waiting restrictions which operate for longer than those times, will remain

4 Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 31st May 1999, and of documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders are available for inspection until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders were made at

(a) the Council's Transport Group offices in Room 24, Lambeth Town Hall, Brixton Hill, London S W 2, between 9 30 a m and 4 30 p m on Mondays to Fridays, and

(b) Brixton Library, Brixton Oval, London S W 2, on Mondays between 1 p m and 8 p m, on Tuesdays and Fridays, between 10 a m and 6 p m, on Thursdays between 10 a m and 8 p m, and on Saturdays between 9 a m and 5 p m

5 If any person wishes to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court

Streets on which parking places will be provided for the use only of vehicles displaying either a valid resident's permit, (including a resident's motor cycle permit), trade permit or visitor's permit

Bankton Road, Barnwell Road, Dalberg Road, Jelf Road, Leeson Road, Mayall Road, Morval Road, Probert Road, Raiton Road, Rattray Road, Talma Road and Trelawn Road
