THE ISLINGTON (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER 1999

THE ISLINGTON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 12) TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER 1999 RELATING TO PROPOSALS TO EXTEND THE ISLINGTON 'E' CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE INTO A FURTHER AREA OF BARNSBURY

Notice is hereby given that the Islington Borough Council is proposing to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended

2 The general nature and effect of the Orders would be to extend the Islington "E" Controlled Parking Zone to include the area which lies generally to the west and north of the existing "E" zone boundary and which would be bounded on the east by Liverpool Road, Barnsbury Park, Thornhill Road and Barnsbury Road, on the west by Roman Way (between Bride Street and Offord Road), Caledonian Road (n b Caledonian Road NOT included), on the north by Bride Street and on the south by Copenhagen Street (between Caledonian Road and Barnsbury Road)

3 The Orders would provide that

(a) parking places would be designated on the streets specified in Schedule 1, 2 or 3 to this notice, a motor cycle parking area would be provided on the street specified in Schedule 4 to this notice and that those parking places and area would be for the use of the vehicle stated at the beginning of each Schedule

(b) the parking places on the streets specified in Schedule 1, 2 or 3 to this notice would operate between 8 30 a m and 6 30 p m on Mondays to Fridays and between 8 30 a m and 1 30 p m on Saturdays (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted),

(c) the parking area on the street specified in Schedule 4 to this notice would operate between 8 30 a m and 6 30 p m on Mondays to Fridays and between 8 30 a m and 1 30 p m on Saturdays,

(d) the charge for a ticket (pay and display) at a parking place referred to in Schedule 2 to this notice or for metered parking at places referred to in Schedule 3 to this notice would be at the rate of £1 20 per hour up to a maximum of 2 hours, with no return within one hour,

(e) the vehicles referred to in Schedule 2 or 3 to this notice in respect of which a "pay and display" or metered charge is paid would be passenger vehicles (8 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles or invalid carriages and the vehicles referred to in Schedule 1, 2 or 3 to this notice in respect of which a residents' parking permit is displayed would be those displaying a valid residents' "E" zone parking permit,

(f) residents' "E" zone parking permits would be issued, on application being made together with payment of the appropriate charge, to any person in respect of a vehicle of the class referred to in sub-paragraph (e) above who satisfies the Council that they are a resident of any street or part of a street specified in Schedule 5 to this notice

Note Residents parking permits issued in respect of parking in the current Islington 'E' Controlled Parking Zone would be available for use in residents' parking places in the proposed extension area and vice versa

(g) the current charges for residents' parking permits are

(i) for a residents' permit £13 for 1 month, £35 for 3 months, £56 for 6 months or £95 for 12 months,

(ii) for a residents' motor cycle permit £4 for 1 month, £12 for 3 months, £21 for 6 months or £35 for 12 months,

(h) certain vehicles may wait, free of charge, in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes) and vehicles displaying a disabled persons' "Orange Badge" in accordance with the regulations relating to the use of that badge (no time limit),

(i) new restrictions on waiting by vehicles would generally apply between 8 30 a m and 6 30 p m on Mondays to Fridays and between 8 30 a m and 1 30 p m on Saturdays in the streets and parts of streets in the proposed extension area. In certain parts of those streets, existing waiting restrictions which operate for longer than those times, would remain

4 Note—It is intended that a residents' visitors voucher system be incorporated into the operation of the controlled parking zone. This issue will be proposed and advertised separately. It is also possible that business parking provision would be introduced into the area once the full needs of businesses in the area have been assessed which would also be advertised separately
