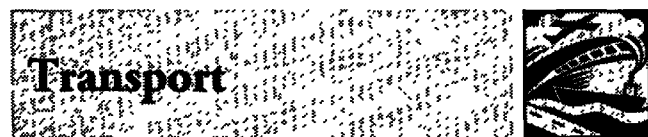

THE GUILDFORD OFF STREET PARKING PLACES (CONSOLIDATION AND AMENDMENT) ORDER 1996 (AS AMENDED)

Notice is hereby given that Guildford Borough Council in exercise of its powers under section 35C of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, have approved a variation in certain parking tariffs currently contained in the Guildford Off Street Parking Places (Consolidation and Amendment) Order 1996 (as amended) Details of the changes are as follows.

These new charges will come into effect on 1st April 1999.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A66 TRUNK ROAD (GREAT CLIFTON) (40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT)

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The effect of the Order will be to extend the current 40 m.p.h. speed limit on the A66 through Great Clifton, eastwards from a point 195 metres east of its junction with Middlegate, where it currently ends, for a distance of 416 metres

A copy of the proposed draft Order, a plan illustrating the proposal and a statement explaining the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected during office hours at Cumbria County Council, Construction Services, Derwent Mill, Wakefield Road, Cockermouth. The documents may also be seen at or obtained by application to the Director, The Highways Agency, PO Box 206, City House, New Station Street, Leeds LS1 4UR.

Any person wishing to object to the Secretary of State's proposal to make this Order should send a written statement of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Director's address given above. The objection should quote HA 28/2/27 and must be received no later than 26th March 1999.
