##### THE A38 TRUNK ROAD (EASTERLY TIDAL FLOW APPROACH TO TAMAR BRIDGE) TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTION

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions intends to make an Order on the A38 Trunk Road, in the county of Cornwall, under section 14(1)(a) (7) and 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, because works are proposed to be executed on the adjacent length of the A38 tidal flow system. This work is associated with the strengthening and widening of the Tamar Bridge.

The effect of the Order would be to impose a temporary mandatory 30 m p h speed restriction on the A38 between a point 182 metres north-west of the Saltash tunnel western entrance and a point 156 metres west of the centre of Tamar Bridge Western Tower.

This would be in the interests of road safety to enable contractors to undertake work on the easterly approach road to the Tamar Bridge.

It is expected that the work would last for approximately 2 years starting on or after 5th April 1999. The Order would come into force on 3rd April 1999 and continue until the work is completed.

The temporary mandatory speed restriction would be clearly indicated by traffic signs throughout the works period.

During the works period, the provisions of The A38 Trunk Road (Saltash Tunnel) (50 m p h Speed Limit) Order 1991, are hereby suspended at such times and to such an extent as may be indicated by traffic signs.

##### THE TOWER HAMLETS (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) (NO. 3) EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC ORDER 1999

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets on 1st March 1999, made the above-mentioned Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of, and Part 1 of Schedule 5, of the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle exceeding 7 feet in width from proceeding in a general north and southbound direction in Belgrave Street, between a point 12 metres south of the southern kerb-line of White Horse Lane and a point 14 metres south of that kerb-line.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 23rd March 1999, can be inspected and obtained during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 6 months from that date at the Council Offices (Traffic) Southern Grove, London E3 4PN.

If the provisions of the Order continue in operation for a period of not less than 6 months, the Borough will consider in due course whether the Order should be reproduced and continued indefinitely by means of an Order under section 6 of the above Act. Persons desiring to object to the making of the Order under section 6 may, within the afore-mentioned period of 6 months, send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Service Head, Street Services at the above address.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision provided therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act or Local Government Act, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

#### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

##### THE M32 MOTORWAY (HAMBROOK INTERCHANGE TO LOWER ASHLEY ROAD INTERCHANGE) AND CONNECTING ROADS SCHEME 1989 (VARIATION) SCHEME 199

##### THE M32 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 2, NORTHBOUND EXIT SLIP ROAD, SPECIAL ROAD) (DETRUNKING) ORDER 199

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Scheme and Order.

A Scheme under sections 16, 17 and 326 of the Highways Act 1980, providing that the M32 Motorway (Hambrook Interchange to Lower Ashley Road Interchange) and Connecting Roads Scheme 1989 to be varied.

The Scheme to be varied authorised him to provide special roads along the routes described in the Schedule to that Scheme.

The Variation Scheme provides that an amended description is substituted in the Schedule to the M32 Motorway (Hambrook Interchange to Lower Ashley Road Interchange) and Connecting Roads Scheme 1989 for the special road which is the northbound exit slip road at Junction 2 connecting the M32 Motorway with the Muller Road/Stapleton Road roundabout.

An Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980, which will provide that a short length of the northbound exit slip road at Junction 2 of the M32 Motorway shall cease to be trunk road and shall be a classified road from the date when the Order comes into effect.

Copies of the Variation Scheme, the 1989 Scheme to be varied, the draft Detrunking Order and any plans referred to in them may be inspected, free of charge, at all reasonable hours from 8th March 1999 until 19th April 1999 or within 6 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice if that period expires later, at the offices of the Highways Agency, Room 414, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol BS2 9DJ, the Highways Agency, Room 5/46A, St Christopher House, Southwark Street, London SE1 0TE, Bristol City Council, Room 327, Legal Division, Council House, College Green, Bristol BS1 5TR, and at the Security Office situated at the entrance to the Eastgate Centre Car Park, Eastville, Bristol.

Any person may object to the making of the Scheme and Order not later than 19th April 1999, or within 6 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice if that period expires later, by notice to the Secretary of State, at the offices of the Highways Agency, Room 503, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol BS2 9DJ, quoting Ref HA 065/030/000001 and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and that statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representations may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
