ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A6514 TRUNK ROAD (VALLEY ROAD, NOTTINGHAM) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS AND "U" TURNS) ORDER 1999

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A6514 Trunk Road known as Valley Road in Nottingham

The effect of the Order would be to prohibit vehicles from

- (a) turning right from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road into Nottingham Road, and,
- (b) making "U" turns from the westbound carriageway to the eastbound carriageway at the junction of the trunk road with Nottingham Road

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan illustrating the proposals and a statement of the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Plan Consortium, Trent Bridge House, Fox Road, West Bridgford, Nottingham, Western Valley Post Office, 304-306 Valley Road, Basford, Nottingham, or obtained by application to the Highways Agency, Network and Customer Services (Midland), Heron House, 49-53 Goldington Road, Bedford MK40 3LL
