HARBOURS ACT 1964

LLANELLI (NORTH DOCK) HARBOUR REVISION ORDER 1999

Notice is hereby given that Carmarthenshire County Council ("the Council") have applied to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions to make a Harbour Revision Order under section 14 of the Harbours Act 1964.

The objects of the proposed Order are to authorise the Council, as the harbour authority for Llanelli Harbour, to construct works in the harbour including a fixed bridge and an impounding wall with a sill and weir penstock and sluices across the entrance to North Dock and to raise and improve the base of North Dock. The Order would also provide for the extinguishment of rights of navigation over North Dock and the part of the river Lhed: immediately to the south of North Dock.

The Secretary of State has determined that this project falls within Annex II to EC Directive 85/337/EEC but whose characteristics require that it need not be made subject to an environmental assessment.
