NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Take notice that R J B Mining (UK) Ltd, of Harworth Park, Blyth Road, Harworth, Doncaster, South Yorkshire DN11 8DB, is applying to the Environment Agency to vary licence serial number 3/28/71/36/G which authorises the abstraction of water from underground strata (Lower Magnesian Limestone) at National Grid Reference SK 5808 7042 (two boreholes) and SK 5753 7035 (one borehole) at Welbeck Colliery, Meden Vale, Mansfield, Nottinghamshire NG20 9PU.

The variation being applied for is to:

- Remove the existing conditions which, with effect from 1st April 2000, reduces the maximum daily quantity from 1,750 cubic metres to 590 cubic metres and the maximum annual quantity from 475,000 cubic metres to 215,530 cubic metres and ceases to authorise the abstraction of water from the borehole at National Grid Reference SK 5753 7035.
- To replace these conditions with one which authorises a maximum annual quantity of 400,000 cubic metres and a maximum daily quantity of 1,750 cubic metres from all three boreholes and a maximum daily quantity of 1,275 cubic metres from the borehole at National Grid Reference SK 5753 7035.
