N Sunday laft the Pope held a publick Chappel in the Church of Santa Maria fopra la Minerva, and affifted with the College of Cardinals at the finging of Te Deum for the Victory obtained by the Imperialists over the Turks, and for the taking of Belgrade: In the Evening there were publick Rejoycings on this Occasion throughout the City; and two Days af-ter Mass was said in all the Churches, for the Souls of those who were kil-led in the several Actions of this Gampaign against the Turks. Don Alexan-der Albani is gone to Castel Gandolfo, to fee to the fitting up of that Palace for the Reception of the Pope, who goes thither next Week for the Bene-fit of the Air. The Abbot Chevalier, who was fent hither by the Court of Erance about the Affair of the Pope's France, about the Affair of the Pope's Conftitution or Bull against Father Quefnel's Book, is fet out on his Return to 'Tis advised from Meffina, that Paris. the Pope's Gallies which ferved this Summer with the Venetian Fleet in the Levant, are performing Quarantine there; and that the Portuguese Squadron is alfo in that Port.

Vienna, Oft. 16. 'Tis confirmed that the Imperialifts have failed in their Enterprize on the Caftle of Zwornick in Bofnia, of the Strength of which Place Prince Eugene appears to have been minformed; for the first Detachment for the Attack of it confisted only of ς or 600 Men, who were afterwards reinforced by about 2000 more; and on Advice of the Turks affembling, in order to relieve it, a third Detachment was made; but before its Arrival the Imperialists had already, on the Approach of a Body of between 1ς and 20000 Turks, raifed the Siege, and abandoned their Baggage, making their Retreat fo late that, the Turks had Time

to fall upon their Rear, to kill 2 or 200 Men, and to take two of their Cannon. Numan Bashaw Kiuprogly, whom the Bofnians last Autumn defired for their Bashaw, commanded that Body of Turks. He also commanded in the late Defeat of the 5000 Croatians; and by these two Actions has acquired Reputation in his Province. There is Advice from the Frontiers, that the late Vizier Halil Bashaw was cut in Pieces by the Soldiery, who in his flead have fet up Ali Bashaw Mactoul Oglu, Son of the famous Cara Muftafa Balhaw, who laid Siege to this City of Vienna in 1683. He is a Man of about 40 Years of Age, faid to be of mean Parts, but has the Character of being a good Horfe-Officer and couragious, having diftin-guifhed himfelf in pufhing the Mufcovite Cavalry in their Retreat before the Action on the Purth. This new Vizier having lately difpatched an Aga to Prince Eugene, with an Overture of Peace, M. Talman, who was formerly the Emperour's Resident in Turkey, is gone from hence to confer with that Aga at Belgrade : In the mean time Prince Eugene ftops at Effeck, and 'tis thought will delay his coming hither till he knows the Refult of those Conferences. The Electoral Prince of Saxony is ill of an Ague, and has not been out of the Cardinal of Saxe-Zeits's House fince his Arrival. On the 11th he fent for the Pope's Nuncio to come and fay Mass before him; the Nuncio attending, his Highness went with him to the Chapel, and passing through his Antichamber where the Polish and Saxon Gentlemen of his Retinue were waiting, he fpoke to the former to accompany him to Mals, and faid to the others that he would pray to God to open their Eyes, as he had to God to open opened his fome Years ago.
