### **THE BRENT (RESTRICTION OF STOPPING ON BUS STOPS) (NO. 3, 1999) (AMENDMENT NO. 5) TRAFFIC ORDER 2000**

### **THE BRENT (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 103) ORDER 2000**

### **THE BRENT (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS) (NO. 2) TRAFFIC ORDER 2000**

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Brent on 2nd May 2000 established a "zebra" crossing in the vicinity of St. Mary and St. Andrew Church and Our Lady of Grace R.C. Junior School under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the "Bus Stops" Order will be to amend the Brent (Restriction of Stopping on Bus Stops) (No. 3) Order 1999 so that the restrictions on stopping by vehicles imposed by that Order will apply "at any time" in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.

3. The prohibition referred to in sub-paragraph 2 above will not apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

4. The general effect of the "Waiting and Loading Restriction" Order will be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:

- (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- (b) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited

between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of street specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;

(c) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the length of street specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;

(d) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. throughout the week in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice, between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of street specified in Schedule 3 and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the length of street specified in Schedule 4;

(e) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 2, 3 and 4 (except on Sundays in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 3 and 4) unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(f) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, will be prohibited;

(g) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer of sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 2 and 4 will be revoked.

5. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 4(a) to 4(d) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" will apply.

6. The general effect of the "Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools" Order will be to:

(a) revoke existing school entrance markings in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 5 to this notice;

(b) prohibit any vehicle stopping or remaining at rest in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 6 to this notice between 8.15 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

7. The prohibition referred to in sub-paragraph 6(b) above will not apply to:

(a) any person causing or permitting a vehicle to stop or remain at rest if that person is obliged to do so in order to prevent an accident or if that person is required to do so by law;

(b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

8. A copy of each of the Orders, which will come into operation on 15th May 2000, of a map of the relevant area, of the above-mentioned Orders of 1974, 1979 and 1995 (and of the Orders which have amended those Orders) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made at:

(a) The One Stop Shop, Brent Town Hall, Forty Lane, Wembley, Middlesex HA9 9HX; and

(b) The One Stop Shop, Brent Town Hall, 349-357 High Road, Wembley, Middlesex HA9 6BZ.

9. Copies of the Orders may be purchased from the address mentioned in paragraph 8(b) above.

10. Any person desiring to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to any of the Orders may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

*Coles Green Road*, the south-west side, from 2 metres north-west of No. 272 Dollis Hill Lane and No. 82 Oxgate Gardens south-eastward for 19 metres.

*Dollis Hill Lane*, the north-west side, from 5 metres south-west of Nos. 276-278 Dollis Hill Lane south-westward for 19 metres.
