ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A30 AND A303 TRUNK ROAD (EXETER TO MARSH) (24 HOURS CLEARWAY) ORDER 2000

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he made this Order on 8th May 2000, coming into force on 18th May 2000, on the A30 and A303 Trunk Road in the counties of Devon and Somerset. The notice of the proposal to make it (Ref. HA41/2/22) was published in Issue No. 55784 of *The London Gazette* on 8th March 2000, and the effect of the Order is described in that notice.
