## Algiers, August 6.

N the 4th Inftant, at the Opening of the City Gates, entred seven Persons in Disguise, who went directly to the Palace defigning to kill the Dey : The Guards at the Palace Gates discovering who they were, opposed their Entrance there, and killed four of them ; the reft fled, and notwithstand-ing a very strict Search has been made throughout the City, they are not to be found. The Conspirators killed two of the Dey's Party, and wounded three or four more. Several have been taken upon Sufpicion of being concerned in this Defign, and three who were related by Marriage to one of the Principal Confpirators that escaped, have been strang. led, though 'tis not known that there was any Evidence of their being guilty. On the 5th between 10 and 11 at Night, a violent Shog of an Earthquake was felt here, but we do not yet hear of any Damage done by it.

Naples, Off. 8. The Portuguese Squadron, which some Time ago returned hither from Corfu, is refitted and supplied with Provifions, fo that they only flay for a fair Wind to fail for Lisbon. A Venetian Man of War named St. Pio, which in a Storm bad loft all her Mafts, and was towed into Reggio by one of the Portuguele Ships, having been refitted, failed fome Days ago for Corfu; but foon after they were out at Sea the Crew mutinied, killed four of the Officers and mortally wound. ed the Captain : Sig. Bembo, a noble Vene-tian, who had the Command in Chief of the Ship, escaped their Fury by begging his Life. Which done, some of them were for carrying the Ship to Smyrna, others to Barbary, but at length they agreed to come to an Anchor about 20 Miles from hence, where about 260 of the Men went afhore and difperfed them-felves into the Country. Advice of this being brought to the Portuguese Admiral, he immediately fent out a Man of War, which has brought the Venetian Ship into this Port, where the will remain till Orders come from Venice, whither an Express is fent with an Account of what has paffed. A Party of Horfe is fent into the Country, to feize those of the

Crew who left the Ship. Lisbon, Off. 25. The Portuguese Squadron is daily expected from the Mediterranean, as is also the Fleet from Brasil. By Letters from the Bahia, which came by a Ship lately arrived from the Azores, 'tis advised that the faid Fleet will bring but little Sugar, those Plantations being very much decreased by the Inquisition's taking up the Planters, who are most of them reputed to be Jews; but the fame Letters say it will bring a confiderable Quantity of Gold. Sig. Mocenigo, a Venetian Nobleman, is on his Way to this Court, as Minister from that Republick.

Minister from that Republick. Vienna, 08.23. On the 19th at Night arrived here Prince Eugene of Savoy, and waited on their Imperial Majestics, by whom he was received with the greateft Marks of Elteem and Favour, and the Empress made him a Present with her own Hands of a Sword, the richest fet with Diamonds that perhaps was ever given on any such Occasion. The next Morning his Highness received the Compliments of the Court on his glorious Campaign. The Electoral Prince of Saxony is recovered of his Agúe, but has not yet been at Court.

Madrid, Off. 18. On the 16th Inftant an Express from Sardinia arrived at the Escurial, with anAccount of the Surrender of the Caffle of Cagliari the Beginning of this Month, upon Articles of Capitulation, by which it was agreed that the Garrion should be transported to Genoa; and Yesterday came Orders hither from the Prefident of the Council of Castile, for Illuminations to be made two Nights successively. 'Tis also advifed from Court, that most of the German Soldiers, at their marching out of Cagliari, lifted among the Spanish Troops; that the Marquels de St. Vicente was made Governour of the faid Place; and that the whole Fleet was to fail to Alguero, except three Men of War commanded by Commadore Don Balthazar de Guevara, which were ordered to Cadiz, where they are to join three others, and take their Station off Cape St. Vincent, there to wait for the Flota which is expected from New Spain, The King has determined to creft an University for all Sciences and Faculties, in the Town of Cer-vera in Catalonia; to diffolve all other Univerfities that have been founded in that Principality, and to appropriate the Revenues of them to the University of Cervera. Don Luis Curiel, one of the Council of Caffile, and of the Inquisition, is made Protector of the faid University.

Hague, Nov. 5. The Dragon, a British Man of War, arrived at Helvoetsluys on the 3d Instant, to convoy over the Lord Cadogan to England; but the Wind having been fince that Time directly contrary, his Excellency is still detained on this Side.

Hampton-Court, OH. 27. His Majefty having been pleafed to appoint Abraham Stanyan, Elq; His Majefty's late Envoy Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary at the Imperial Court, to be his Ambaffadour in Ordinary to the Grand Signor; the Right Honourable the Lord Onflow Governour of the Turkey Company, together with feveral Merchants trading to the Levant and deputed on this Occasion, waited this Day on His Majefty, being introduced by the Right Honourable Joseph Addison, Elq; one of His Majefty's Principal Secretaries of State. They were all admitted to kiss His Majefty's Hand, who was pleafed to confer the Honour of Knighthood on Timothy Lannoy, Philip Jackson, William Hammond, John Lock, John Bull, and Charles Vernon, Elqs; After which they were, by His Majefty's Command, entertained at Dinner by the Officers of His Majefty's Board of Green-Cloath.
