# GREEN LANES, PALMERS GREEN—FREE PARKING PLACES (1 HOUR MAXIMUM PARKING PERIOD)

#### THE CHINE, COLVILLE ROAD, DENNY ROAD, ELMHURST ROAD, FELIXSTOWE ROAD, GREEN LANES, HASELBURY ROAD AND LANGHEDGE LANE—DISABLED PARKING PLACES

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield, on 5th June 2000, made the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. 156) Order 2000, Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Palmers Green) (No. 1) Order 2000 and the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 2) Order 2000, under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The general effect of the Order will be to amend the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) Order 1994, so that the hours during which the existing prohibition applies on:

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be changed so that it will apply at any time in the length of street specified in the Schedule 1 to this notice;

(b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be changed so that it will apply at any time in the length of street referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above.

The effect of the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Palmers Green) (Special Parking Area) (No. 1) Order 2000 will be to:

(a) revoke the designation by the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Palmers Green) (Special Parking Area) (No. 1) Order 1995 of the parking place numbered 1 situated in Green Lanes, Palmers Green;

(b) designate free parking places in the lengths of Green Lanes, Palmers Green specified in Schedule 2 to this notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for a period of one hour without charge between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);

(c) provide that no vehicle which has left a parking place referred to in paragraph (b) above may return to that parking place within a period of one hour;

(d) specify, in respect of the parking places, that passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles or invalid carriages may be left therein;

(e) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances.

The general effect of the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 2) Order 2000 will be to revoke the designation by the Order of 1994 of the parking places numbered 57 and 118 therein situated in The Chine and Felixstowe Road, the designation by the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 6) Order 1997 of the parking place numbered 231 therein situated in Colville Road, the designation by the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 7) Order 1997 of the parking place numbered 238 therein situated in Green Lanes, the designation by the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 3) Order 1998 of the parking place numbered 248 therein situated in Langhedge Lane, the designation by the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 4) Order 1998 of the parking places numbered 254 and 255 therein situated in Denny Road and Elmhurst Road and the designation by the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 2) Order 1999 of the parking place numbered 303 therein situated in Haselbury Road.

The Short Term Parking Places Order will come into operation for the purposes of the marking on the carriageway of parking places and the placing of traffic signs, etc., on 26th June 2000, and for all other purposes on 12th June 2000. The Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Disabled Persons Orders will come into operation on 12th June 2000.

A copy of the Order, of the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) Order 1994, the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Palmers Green) (Special Parking Area) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1995 and of the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Special Parking Area) (No. 1) Order 1994 (and of the Orders which have previously amended or applied that Order), of a map indicating the location and effect of the Order and of the Council's statement of reason for proposing to make the Order can be inspected at the Reception Desk,

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

### Schedule 1

Change existing waiting and loading restrictions to at any time

Green Lanes, Palmers Green:

(a) the north-west side, between a point 6 metres south-west of a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 390 and 388 Green Lanes and a point 1 metre north-east of a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 380 and 382 Green Lanes.

(b) the north-west side, between a point 1 metre north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 507 and 509 Green Lanes and a point 7.50 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 497 and 499 Green Lanes.

*Free Parking Places for up to 1 hour (No return within 1 hour) 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday* 

*Green Lanes*, Palmers Green, the north-west side, from a point 6 metres south-west of the party wall of Nos. 390-388 Green Lanes north-eastward for a distance of 17 metres:

(a) the south-east side, from a point 5 metres north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 452-454 Green Lanes south-westward for a distance of 25 metres.

THE HARINGEY (WOOD GREEN) (PARKING PLACES) (NO. 1) AMENDMENT ORDER 2000

Notice is hereby given, that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey proposes to make the above-mentioned Order, under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 51 of the Road Traffic Regulations 1984, which will have the effect of amending the Haringey (Wood Green) (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1994 (as already amended by the Haringey (Wood Green) (Parking Places) (No. 1) (Amendment) Order 1996 and the Haringey (Wood Green) (Parking Places) (No. 1) (Amendment) Order 1997 and the Haringey (Wood Green) (Parking Places) (No. 1) (Amendment) Order 1999 and the Haringey (Wood Green) (Parking Places) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order 1999) which regulates the operation of the Wood Green Controlled Parking Zone.

The general effect of the Amendment will be as follows:

To amend the Wood Green Controlled Parking Zone by dividing the Controlled Parking Zone into two Zones:

(a) Inner Zone consisting of the following roads:

Acacia Road, Alexandra Road, Ashley Crescent, Berners Road, Brabant Road, Brampton Park Road, Burghley Road, Bury Road, Cobham Road, Coleraine Road, Coombe Road, Courcy Road, Cranbrook Park, Crescent Road, Cumberland Road, Gathorne Road, Gladstone Avenue, Glynne Road, Hewitt Avenue, High Road, High Road (Passages to the rear of and known as Hazel Mews, Amber Mews, Wallis Mews, Lilac Mews, and Walnut Mews), Lakefield Road, Lymington Avenue, Lyttleton Road, Malvern Road, Meads Road, Morley Road, Morley Avenue, Moselle Avenue, Park Ridings, Parkland Road, Pelham Road, Ravenstone Road, Redvers Road, Ringslade Road, River Park Road, Russell Avenue, Salisbury Road, St Albans Crescent, Station Road, The Avenue, The Sandlings, Tower Terrace, Vernon Road, Vincent Road N.22, Waldegrave Road, Watsons Road, Wellesley Road, Westbeech Road, Whymark Avenue, Willingdon Road and Winkfield Road.

(b) *Outer Zone* consisting of the following roads:
