The three British Men of War, which had for fome Time cruifed on the Coast of Norway, came in here a few Days ago to revictual, and are now in a Readineis to fail with the first fair Wind to take their Station in the North Sea. On the 4th arrived 11 English Merchant Ships from the Baltick, under the Convoy of three British Men of War and a Frigate 3 which will take the first Opportunity of a Wind to proceed to England.

Drefden, Dec. 8. On the ist Instant the King of Poland set out from hence on his Return to that Kingdom, and by Letters which came Yesterday from the Frontiers of Silesia, 'tis advised, that his Majesty is arrived at Frau-Hadr.

Hague, Dec. 17. The States of the Pro-vioce of Holland affembled on the 10th Infant, and have under Deliberation the fitting out a Squadron of Men of War to be fent to the Baltick and the North Sea.
