##### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Take notice that Spring Shades Ltd, of 36 Friday Street, Leicester LE1 3BW, is applying to the Environment Agency for a licence to abstract water from River Soar canal and borehole at National Grid Reference SK 5850 0538, at 36 Friday Street, Leicester.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: canal 24.8 cubic metres per hour, 595 cubic metres per day and 200,000 cubic metres all year round. Borehole 6.25 cubic metres per hour, 150 cubic metres per day and 50,000 cubic metres (all year round). The water will be used for process dyeing.

##### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CONSENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECTION 88
