N the 1ft Inftant Mr. Stanyan had his Audience of Leave of the Emperour as Envoy to this Court, and is to have his feveral Audiences of Leave of the reft of the Imperial Family very fpeedily. Some Days ago Prince Eu-gene's Anfwer to the Grand Vizier's laft Letter brought by M. Hefferman, Mr. Wortley's Secretary, was difpatch-ed by an Express; who 'tis reckoned may return with the Vizier's Reply about the 20th Inftant : Immediately after which, the British Ambassadours Mr. Stanyan and Sir Robert Sutton, will fet out for Belgrade, on their Way to the Ottoman Port. The Nobility of the States of Lower Auftria, having in Confideration of his extraordinary Merits, voluntarily chosen Prince Eugene of Savoy into their Body, and given him Selfion and Voice in their Affembly, and having alfo made the like Compliment to his Nephew Prince Emanuel of Savoy, Lieutenant-Field-Marshal in the Emperour's Service, they were both introduced Yesterday into the Provincial Palace, and took their Seats in the Affembly, a Speech being made at their Admission by Count Enckevoirt in the Name of the Nobility, which was answered by Count Windifgratz on the Part of their Highnesses. 'Tis advised from Belgrade, that the Governour of that Place has ordered out a strong Detachment, to go and take their Winter-Quarters upon the Morava, whither they are marched accordingly, and defign to extend themfelves along that River, to prevent the Turks making any Incursions on this Side of it.

Copenbagen, Dec. 14. Upon the earnest and repeated Instances of the Lord Polwarth, His Britannick Majeflys Minifter at this Court, in behalf of the Ships belonging to Hambourg which had been ftopped upon the Elbe, his Danish Ma-jefty fent Orders fome Days ago for their being all releafed, which has been done accordingly. The Mafters of fome Ships which are newly arrived from Dantzick, report, that five or fx Swe-dish Men of War have put to sea non Carlfcroon ; whereupon Orders are given to four Men of War to fail from hence into the Baltick, for the Security of our Commerce with the Town of Lubeck and other Places. On the 10th Inftant Commadore Tordenschild arrived here from Norway, in a fmall Veffel having but two Guns; in his Paffage he was attacked by a Swedish Ship of 14 Guns, but making a brave Defence, with the Lofs of 4 of his Men out of 16, he got clear of her. On the 10th a Contract was made here, for Ten Thousand Ton of Meal, for the Army in Norway; and the fame is to be furnished in a few Weeks. The fame Day a Repartition of Quarters was fettled by the Royal Council for three new Regiments of Dragoons; half of which are to be on the lile of Zeland, and the reft are ordered to Jutland and Fuhnen.

Hague, Dec. 21. The States of the Province of Holland feparated on the 17th Inftant in the Afternoon, after having refolved upon the fitting out of 30 Men of War for the Baltick. The faid Refolution has been transmitted to the States General, to be communicated to the reft of the Provinces; and on Thurfday next the 23d, the Deputies of the States of Holland are to come hither again, to proceed further in this Affair.
