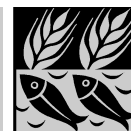

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CONSENT IN PURSUANCE OF SCHEDULE 10

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991, as amended by the Environment Act 1995, that an application has been made to the Environment Agency by British Sugar plc, for consent to discharge trade effluent. The application is for a consent to discharge up to a maximum of 65 cubic metres per day of trade effluent from Cornerways Nurseries, Wisington, Norfolk, into The Wisington Drain catchment at National Grid Reference TL 9820 6555.

The discharge proposed is of waste water effluent from a new glasshouse irrigation system. Cornerways Nurseries is within the Borough Council of Kings Lynn & West Norfolk and Norfolk County Council areas.

The Wisington Drain system has no recognized uses. The drain is a tributary, by pumping, of the River Wissey, which has the uses of River Ecosystem 3, industrial water supply, spray irrigation, livestock watering and moderate amenity.
