Unless the Order is suspended or quashed as a consequence of any such application, any person who on 23rd April 2001 has/had an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order relates, may claim to be entitled to be compensated by the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council in respect of any depreciation in value of his or her interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable. Any claim must be served on the Council at its above address within a period of 6 months from 23rd April 2001 unless the period is extended in any particular case by the Secretary of State.
