If the provisions of the Order continue in operation for a period of at least 18 months, the London Borough of Southwark will consider in due course whether the provisions of the Order should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order under section 6 of the said Act of 1984.

Within a period of 18 months from the coming into force of the Order or if the Order is subsequently varied by another Order under section 9 or modified pursuant to sub-section (2) or section 1 of the 1984 Act from coming into operation of that variation or modification (whichever is latest), any person may object to the making of an Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation and should send a statement in writing of their objection and grounds thereof to the Director of Regeneration and Environmental Department, Council Offices, Chiltern House, Portland Street, London SE17 2ES.

Any persons desiring to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained therein on the ground that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which this Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL ROAD WORKS

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Take notice that W Lee & Co., of Corner Farm, Burshill, Brandesburton, Driffield, East Yorkshire YO25 8LY, is applying to the Environment Agency for a licence to abstract water from the River Hull between TA 0805 4910 and TA 0790 4880 and TA 0799 4981 and TA 0791 4946 at Hallytreeholme Farm, Brandesburton and Hunthill Farm, Hempholme.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 74 cubic metres per hour, 822 cubic metres per day, and 18,000 cubic metres per annum.

The water will be used for Spray Irrigation. This application is to replace a time limited licence due to expire. There is no increase in quantities.
