London Borough of Croydon THE CROYDON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 8) TRAFFIC ORDER 2001

Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Croydon, on 25th June 2001, made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to further amend the Croydon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2000 so that:

(a) waiting restrictions would be revoked in that length of Waddon Road, the east to west arm, the south-east side, between a point opposite the south-western kerb-line of Rigby Close and a point 2 meters north-east of a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 110 and 112 Waddon Road;

(b) waiting by vehicles would be prohibited:

(i) at any time throughout the week in those lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;

(ii) between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in that length of Rigby Close, the south-west side, from its junction with Waddon Road north-westward for a distance of 9 metres.

(iii) between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in Waddon Road, the east to west arm, the north-west side, from a point 10 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Vicarage Road north-eastward for a distance of 31 metres.

(c) loading and unloading by vehicles would be prohibited between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in those lengths of Rigby Close and Waddon Road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

3.
